# Mystic River Pinot Blanc

Okanagan Valley

***“Most Awarded Pinot Blanc at the Lieutenant Governor’s Annual Awards of Winemaking Excellence”***

We like to think this is the house wine at the BC Lieutenant Governor’s House, but we’re not sure because we haven’t been invited to dinner yet! Produced from a single estate vineyard, layers of top soil followed by pure gravel spells excellent terroir for this varietal. This small production wine has a nose that shows melon, grapefruit and vanilla, while the palate tastes of anise, pear and rose hips. The mouthfeel is balanced with a lengthy finish that goes on and on and on and...
